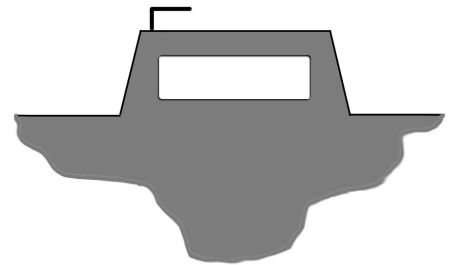

Congratulations! You have made an incredible investment your show! *OFF THE METER* is...well....off the meter! Okay we've established that you know how to pick good props, so now let's discuss ways hold it.

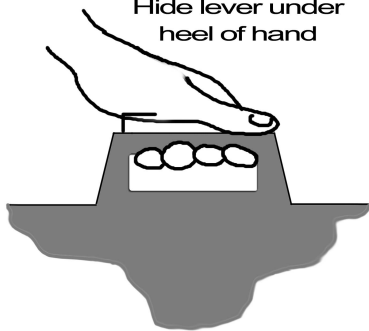
First unlock the black locks on the side of the box used to keep the meter closed only during transportation. The lever at the top of the handle will be pressed down to move the needle from low to high numbers. The explosion is achieved by simply releasing the front of the box and holding onto the back handle.

HAND POSITIONS

Here are a few different hand positions. You will develop your own favorite so please experiment and share your favorite with us.

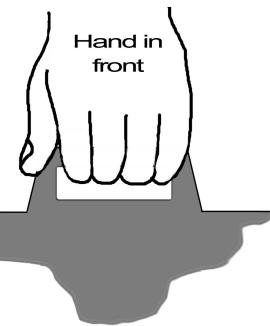
SIDE HEEL PRESS

I use the side heel press in the video at the video on the website.

Release is easy – just let go of the front and hold the back with all 4 fingers.

HAND IN FRONT

This method is really good for the pressing, but the release is trickier. When read to release this, put your thumb under the handle in back, and release all 4 fingers in front.
